Area	Recommendation / observation	Priority
Kitchen	Consider adding a single lowered counter with clear space below underneath the window	Low
Lighting	Consider increasing the levels of lighting throughout external spaces, including stairwells	Medium
Internal Stairs	Alter surface to ensure slip resistance	Medium
Common Room	No recommendations	
laundry	Install no slip surface which does not prevent a tripping hazard	High
toilet	Replace locks to ones which can be operated with a closed fist	Medium
	Consider combining the two toilets into one larger toilet laid out in accordance with Doc M guidance	Medium
bedroom	Install a grab rail at the front door	Medium
room	Install grab rails to the sides of the toilet.	Low
